What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your hard drive by a web server, which essentially functions as an identity document. Cookies cannot spread viruses or install dangerous files. Cookies are unique, which means they can only be read by the server that has set the cookie on a hard drive.

Cookies are regular text files; they are not software. Cookies will not delete data from your computer nor do they send information in the background. In exceptional cases, cookies could affect your privacy because they could store personal data; such as your surfing behaviour or confidential information, including passwords. Direct cookies from reliable websites generally do not pose a risk, but caution is advised when dealing with indirect cookies or cookies from unknown or questionable websites.

Why Do We Set Cookies?

Cookies help save you and us time. They help us determine which data is relevant to our visitors and which is not, which in turn enables us to remove irrelevant web pages and focus on the content that is important to you. Like all other websites in the Netherlands, we are legally required to inform visitors about the cookies used by our company. An overview of these is listed below.

Types of Cookies

There are different types of cookies. Firstly, an important distinction should be made between permanent and temporary cookies.

- Permanent cookies will remain on your PC or mobile device, even after the browser has been closed.
- Temporary cookies are session-bound and are deleted once the browser is closed.

Secondly, there is a distinction between direct and indirect cookies:

- Direct cookies (first-party cookies) are set by the website you are visiting.
- Indirect cookies (third-party cookies) are set by third parties, such as advertisers.

Our session cookies are used to determine which parts of our website were viewed during your visit. This enables us to provide more tailored services that better suit your needs and those of other visitors. Such cookies are automatically deleted once the browser is closed.
